
COMMUNITY CHURCH AUDITORIUM TO BE USED SUNDAY FIRST TIME

Reading Chronicle, March 21, 1924

"The [Unitarian] Church will hold its first service in the main auditorium of the new building next Sunday morning."

"The members of the church are planning to make the morning service a worthy beginning of that form of spiritual worship to which the church is to be dedicated...
